# Roadmap for OCEANS to become more independent

- Engage in contracts, gain more funding from outside sources, become independent entity that does not solely depend on the EC for funding.
- Become a legal entity by the end of the term
- Discuss with the board as to which country is most strategic to be registered in
- Looking into legal requirements of each country and what documents are needed
- Check if documents can be provided digitally or need to be sent to register in the countries
- Good examples: ESN and EMA now independent even if it also took them some time

## **Funding**

- Partnership with other ESAA partner organisations
- Send proposals (e.g., for projects)
- Shared funding source with other members of ESAA
- Marketing and sponsorship unit: find sponsors, develop marketing strategy, new members and sponsor members
